### **A bit more detail:**

- Deputise for the Chair, and chair meetings of the Board or represent The Lacrosse Foundation to external stakeholders as required.
- Promote The Lacrosse Foundation and act as a figurehead.
- Assist and support the Chair in providing leadership to the Board, through the governance arrangements, and also acting as a 'sounding board' and confidante to the Chair in the execution of their role.
- Determine, in conjunction with the Chair, meeting agendas, helping to monitor that they are forward looking, focused on strategic matters and include all matters of concern to all meeting attendees.
- Manage succession planning and ensure the board includes individuals with requisite skills.
- Ensure an inclusive approach to the diverse range of lacrosse interests
- We anticipate that the role will require a commitment of between 1-2 hours per week, with flexibility for you to schedule this around your other activities.
- *NB. This is currently a Trustee role, so you will also be required to attend each monthly Trustee Board meeting - and you may be asked to join other meetings via Zoom with other trustees/volunteers).*

- Able to work using own initiative
